The Singapore International Story Telling Festival 2007 and Acropolis English Centre proudly present "Stories My Grandparents Told Me: A Storytelling Competition" to be held in August 2007. The event aims to foster inter-generational understanding and appreciation of shared histories and traditions among family members.

THEME

Stories My Grandparents Told Me

OBJECTIVES

- To encourage children to value the memories & real life experiences of the aged;
- To encourage children to record and commit to memory, stories told to them by their grandparents;
- To promote cross-generation bonding;
- To encourage the telling of stories in a succinct yet highly stimulating way.
- To promote the use of English for oral presentations.

CATEGORIES

Category 1: Pupils of P1 and P2 Category 2: Pupils of P3 and P4 Category 3: Pupils pf P5 and P6

Each school is encouraged to send one pupil for each category. A school is allowed a maximum of **3 representatives**, one for each category. Four finalists will be selected from each category where there will be 2 winning prizes and 2 consolation prizes.

LENGTH & TYPE OF STORY

Length: The story must be presented within the time limit of **3 minutes.** The story can be of any genre but it should have been told to the child by an elder, preferably his/her grandparent. Personal experience stories such as those related to memories of war, migration, hardships, customs, friendships and school life are preferred. (download **COMPETITION RULES AND GUIDELINES**)

INVITATION

All participating schools whose pupils have qualified for the finals would be given 10 invitation cards for supporters and well-wishers for the Grand Final on 27th August. Finalists are encouraged to come with their grandparents or the elderly family members who inspired their stories.

Schools are also encouraged to bring supporters along. The care of participants and supporters from each school, including all transport arrangements, is the responsibility of the school.

JUDGING

The adjudicators will be from the Singapore International Story Telling Festival 2007, the Asian Storytelling Network and Acropolis English Centre. The contestants will be judged based on the following criteria: Originality, 10 points; Relevance, 10; Diction, 20; and Expression, 20 for a total of 60 points.

SPECIAL GUEST

There will be a special storytelling performance to entertain the audience after the competition and while the judges are finalising the results.
